Rajendra Dengle was born in Mumbai and brought up in Pune where he attended school and college, majoring in German Literature and Philosophy. He did his M.A. and PhD from Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU) on the dramatic and narrative works of Ödön von Horváth. He taught at the Centre of German Studies, JNU, for 42 years, retiring in July 2021. His research interests have been Philosophy of Language, Theories of Literature, Communication and the New Media. He has been Secretary of the Goethe Society of India and Editor of its Yearbook. He has published research papers on Friedrich Schiller, Ödön von Horváth, Fritz Mauthner, and Vilém Flusser. He has translated literary texts from Marathi into German (Vishram Bedekar, D. B Mokashi) and from German into Hindi (Herta Mueller). Apart from his academic work, he has been Dean of Students and Dean of the School of Language, Literature, and Culture Studies of JNU.
